Tests have revealed that she has a leaky valve and her aorta is not working correctly in her heart. They are treating her with medication to bring down the blood pressure and to see if that will help with the leaky valve. She's had fluid in her lungs due to her heart not working efficiently. They drained the fluid in her lungs and she's feeling better and can breathe better at this point. She came home on Friday. Please be in prayer for Sally at this time.
