Please pray for Nancy, Tazabella and Halogloe. Especially, pray for Nancy as she undergoes the process of saying goodbye to Curt. Thankfully, Curt was a believer, so we know that he is with the Lord. However, there are a lot of hard things that Nancy is going to face in the days ahead. My prayer is that we as a church body will rally around her and the girls to love, comfort and serve their needs in practical ways. As needs arise, we will do our best to communicate them to you.

I am thankful that at the worst times of life we have God's Word and God's Spirit to comfort us. This morning, I spent some time in Psalm 34, and even prayed portions of this Psalm for Nancy and her girls. Specifically, I am grateful for verse 18, which promises, "The Lord is near to the brokenhearted and saves the crushed in spirit."

I am also aware that at times like this, we often do not know exactly what to pray for. Here are some things we could join together in praying for this family - that God would bring them peace, provide them with comfort, let them know that He tenderly cares for each one of them, and that God's presence would provide rest, and healing for their broken hearts. I love you and thank God for the privilege it is to serve you."
